- Assist in the cleaning, upkeep, and preservation of exhibit consumables
- Provide support to the Visitor Experience team by preparing any materials needed for public programs
- Be a helpful, positive, and engaged member of the London Children's Museum volunteer team
- Assist in exhibit observation checklist completion to determine the needs of visitors in our space
